Frequently Asked Questions

How many people are needed for a co-op?

A minimum of four boxes are needed to start a co-op.

I set up the co-op online, now what do I do?

Next, you will need to invite members to join your co-op.

To invite members:

1. Log on to the website and click "My Account" in the upper right. Then go to "Manage My Co-op" and click on "Members."
2. Enter their name, email address, a short message, and click "submit."
3. An email will then be sent with a link to join the co-op.

What if the co-op location is going to be closed?

If you are the co-op leader, you can schedule holidays and closures online. Click on "Holidays & Closures" on the "Manage My Co-op" page. Then enter the dates the co-op will be closed. We will deliver boxes to members' homes on those days.

Are all boxes in a co-op the same?

Definitely not. Each person can choose from four different box sizes. These boxes can be all fruit, all veggie, or a combo of both. Each person can set their own account preferences and customize their own orders.

At Door to Door Organics, we make it easy and convenient for people to come together and support healthy eating. Our co-op program gives your community the power to raise money while maintaining the flexibility of individual accounts.

Fundraising With Door to Door Organics

Door to Door Organics is committed not only to healthy bodies and a healthy planet, but also to supporting the diverse groups that exist in the communities we serve.

Through our fundraising program, we bring you Good Food and help support the organizations you love. When a co-op is a qualifying nonprofit, like a school, or partners with one, you can elect to have 10% of box sales given to the organization. In 2012, we donated nearly \$20,000 to qualifying nonprofits.

What Is a Co-op?

You can form a co-op when four or more boxes are delivered to the same location, like a school or office. Each co-op has a leader that is responsible for setting up the co-op online, inviting new members, and managing when the co-op cannot accept deliveries, i.e., holidays. Each co-op member has individual control over their account, such as box size, account preferences, and substitutions. Everyone simply picks up their box at the same location as their co-op buddies.

How Do I Start a Co-op?

Starting and managing a co-op can all be done online. To start a co-op:

1. Log in to your Door To Door Organics account or sign up for an account at colorado.doortodoororganics.com.
2. Once you are logged in, click on "My Account" in the upper right corner.
3. Then go to "Manage My Co-op," click "Start Co-op".
4. Select "Fundraiser Co-op," enter the co-op name, and then type a short description about the co-op and where the donated money will be going.
5. Next, enter special delivery instructions and the co-op delivery address.
6. Enter the nonprofit information. *Note: You will need to enter the tax ID for the nonprofit.*
7. Now you can invite members to join. Click on "Members" and enter their names, email addresses, and a short message. Click "Submit" to send them an email with a link to join the co-op.
